

REACH declaration on regulation (EC) no. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals

iC-Haus is a manufacturer and supplier of integrated circuits and microelectronic systems which are classed as "articles" in the sense of the EU REACH regulation¹. As iC-Haus articles do not release any substances when used correctly, they must not be registered under REACH.


Notwithstanding registration, according to Article 33 of REACH we have a duty to inform our customers should at least one substance of very high concern (SVHC) be contained in one of the products supplied by us in a concentration of at least 0.1% weight by weight (w/w). The current list of SVHCs includes 219 substances to date. (<https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table>).

In the interests of a high level of supply and product safety our suppliers are obliged to inform us of their own accord and without delay should an SVHC above 0.1% weight by weight be contained in a product or a substance delivered to us.

Should we receive information to this effect and through this obtain knowledge that the 0.1% weight by weight limit for an SVHC is therefore also exceeded in our products, those customers affected will be immediately informed.

According to our present knowledge and in view of the information provided by our suppliers, our products do not contain any SVHCs in a concentration of above 0.1% weight by weight.

Conformity with REACH is also confirmed on each of our delivery notes. Should packaging materials be used which are not REACH conform, this is expressly indicated on our delivery notes.
